After lunch we will join the Thames Path to O2 and the Millennium Village before taking the Cable Car (additional charge) across the river to the Royal Docks for a brief visit to The Crystal Exhibition. We can return to central London by DLR/Jubilee from Royal Victoria Dock or back on the Jubilee line from North Greenwich. - 3 Miles
